We also cannot accept the items listed below. Thank you for your understanding and your generosity.

ITEMS WE DO NOT ACCEPT

Pianos/organs

Large office desks/metal desks/cubicles

Photocopiers and other large office equipment

Exercise equipment (treadmills, universal gyms, weights)

Select building materials (sinks, light fixtures, shingles, wood, etc.)

Hazardous materials (lighter fluid, paint thinner, paint, etc.)

TVs older than 5 years (unless they are flat screen)

Cribs, carseats, strollers

Entertainment centers

Dishwashers

Gas-powered appliances
