Due to the growing cost of disposing of unsellable items*, please donate items that are clean and in good repair.

🛕 ITEMS WE DO NOT ACCEPT: 🛕



Cribs, carseats, strollers Dishwashers Entertainment centers Gas-powered appliances

Hazardous materials (lighter fluid, paint thinner, paint, etc.)

Large appliances

Large exercise equipment (treadmills, etc.) Large office desks/metal desks/cubicles Pianos/organs

Photocopiers and other large office equipment Select building materials (sinks, light fixtures, shingles, wood, etc.) TVs older than 5 years (unless they are flat screen)

Items left to the discretion of staff:

Children's items (no stains, odors, pet hair) Leather & cloth furniture (no cracking, tears, stains, odors, pet hair) Mattresses (no stains, rips, odors, pet hair) Small exercise equipment (must be in clean, working condition) Wooden/metal/plastic furniture (no damage or repair work needed)

INDIVIDUAL STORES MAY DIFFER

On occasion, individual stores may not be able to accept certain items. The Coeur d'Alene store cannot accept headboards and bedframes due to space limitations. Feel free to call ahead if you have an item you are unsure about.

*Disposing of unsellable items costs UGM money that could be used for homeless services.
