- Train, empower, and manage associate staff to provide pastoral care and counseling.
- Learn and oversee the implementation of the Genesis Process curriculum.
- Lead process groups and teach classes as assigned.
- Fulfill additional team duties.

- Experience with addiction recovery counseling and trauma therapy
