

Job Title: Production Cook

A successful applicant will utilize culinary skills while getting to know UGM residents, volunteers, partners and our Christ-centered approach to ending homelessness.

Responsibilities:

- Provide training and supervision of kitchen personnel, including guests, residents and volunteers.
- Supervise the preparing, cooking, serving and cleaning for assigned meal periods under the direction of the Production Chef.
- Ensure operations are in alignment with UGM's philosophy and mission statement.
- Assist the Production Chef by fulfilling assigned tasks.
- Maintain a safe and secure environment compliant with all SRHD food safety standards and OSHA workplace safety standards.

Required Qualifications:

- Two years of cooking experience, with demonstrated preparation and production skills.
- Proven ability to be innovative and work with a variable menu.
- Strong sense of calling to minister to individuals while utilizing culinary skills.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Available to work one day during the weekend (scheduling will accommodate regular church attendance).
- Available to work special events, select holidays and at various UGM locations as needed.
- Basic computer skills (i.e. Word, Excel, Outlook).

Preferred Qualifications:

- Three years' cooking experience, with demonstrated preparation and production skills.
- Two years supervisory experience.
- Culinary degree or recognized culinary certification.
- Experience working with people who are homeless or in recovery and/or personal experience with recovery (successfully worked through personal issues).
- Leadership experience within an active ministry.
